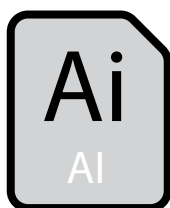


How Do I - Laser Cut

You can cut, score and engrave acrylic plastic, plywood, paper and card on the trotec laser cutters in the 3D workshop.

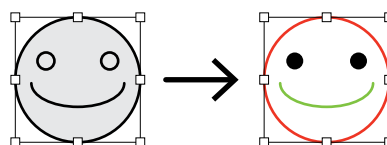
1 You need an .ai Adobe Illustrator vector file.

You can sign up for workshops on Adobe Illustrator in the Digital Space.



2 Change the colour of the outlines of your design so the laser cutter can read them.

The laser cutter will cut out red outlines, score green outlines and engrave black outlines.

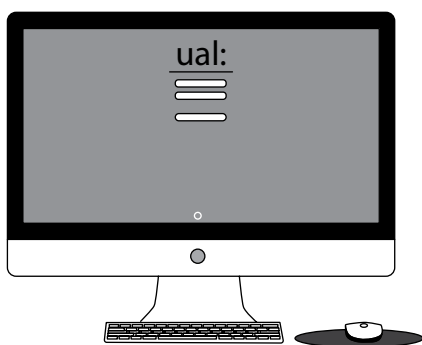

3 Book a laser cutter on the [ORB](#).

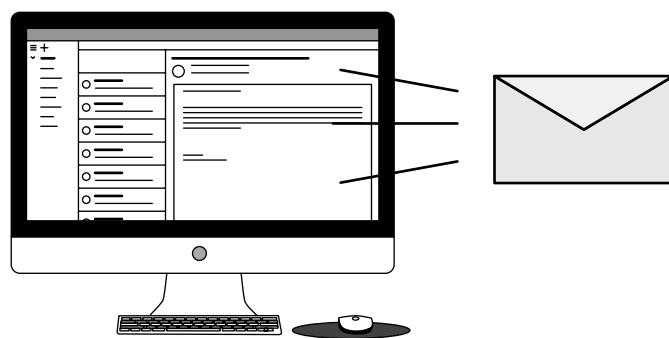

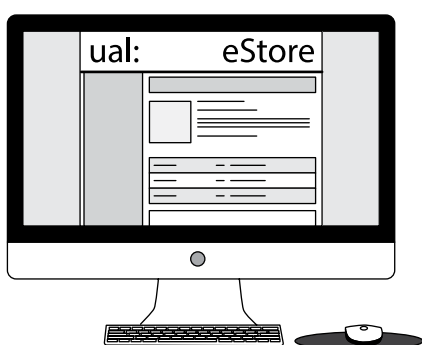
4 Email your .ai file to 3dworkshoplcc@arts.ac.uk by 10 am the day before you have booked.

Email subject heading should be: Laser cutting + name + collection time.



5 The technician will let you know how much the job cost and when you can collect it.

Artboards should be labeled with the corresponding material to be laser cut.
